



Conditions of Entry

2018 YP Art Exhibition

****Artwork entered must not have been exhibited competitively (excluding local agricultural shows) within the Yorke Peninsula Council area in the last two years***

Terms of Entry

1. Open Entry fees are \$15.00 GST Inc for each work.
2. All entries must be the original uncopied work of the exhibiting artist.
3. All entries must be accompanied by a signed 'Entry Form'. If a person other than the artist signs the Entry Form he/she must have authority from the artist. Entry forms can be completed on, posted or delivered to Yorke Peninsula Council c/- Art Exhibition PO Box 57 Maitland SA 5573.
4. Entries must be received by **8pm Monday 12th March 2018**.
5. All works must be for sale for the duration of the exhibition.
6. Each work must clearly show the artist's name and address; the title of the art work, the medium; the relevant judging category/ies and the price on the back - top right hand side. All entries are submitted at the total risk of the artist. The artist indemnifies the committee of the Yorke Peninsula Art Exhibition against any claim, loss or damage of whatever nature or cause however occurring and whether directly or indirectly relating to entered works or their delivery or display.
7. No painting or photography entry is to exceed 1.5 square metres in size including the frame. No sculpture entry is to exceed 2 mtrs x 2 mtrs. Oversize entries will be rejected.
8. All entry fees are compulsory and will not be refunded under any circumstances.
9. Artwork must not contain any material or content that is infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, pornographic or otherwise objectionable.
10. Receipts will not be posted unless specially requested.
11. By completing and signing an Entry Form to enter any work/s in the YP Art Exhibition, the entrant gives permission for the Committee to reproduce any work submitted for the purpose of publicity, promotion of the exhibition, education, preparation of the catalogue and sale of items without payment of fee, royalty or other remuneration.
12. In the event that any artwork is deemed unsuitable or does not meet the competition criteria, the competition organiser reserves the right to withdraw it from the competition.

Judging and Display

1. All judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
2. All entries will be eligible for judging in the Open Section of the relevant category.
3. The Committee reserves the right not to award a prize in any category of the competition if, in the opinion of the judge/s, no work is of sufficient merit.

Painting

1. Artists whose principal residence is in the Yorke Peninsula Council area will also be eligible to enter the 'Verna Lock Memorial award for Local Artists'.
2. An artist may enter a maximum of five (5) 2D traditional medium artworks.
3. Entries for an artist must be entered on a single Entry Form.
4. All entries must be suitably framed and ready for hanging with the wire tensioned so that the hanging point is 75mm below the centre top of the frame with flush D hangers (not screw eyes). Stretched canvas is considered framed but must have rigid and adequate cross members. All fittings for hanging wires must be in the top third of the frame. Paintings must be supplied with wire, not cord.
5. All entries must include a photograph of the painting (for inclusion in the catalogue) and a brief 'Artist Statement' (max. 100 words) including a description of the painting and materials used. The Artist Statement will accompany the work on display.
6. Paintings will be displayed at the Ardrossan Town Hall over the Easter long weekend. Open Thursday 29th March 2018, Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Sunday 9:30am to 4:00pm and Monday 9:30am to 12:00pm.

Receipt and Collection of Paintings

1. Personal delivery of paintings – Saturday 24th March 2018 between 9am and 4.00pm at the Ardrossan Town Hall.
2. Personal collection of works at Ardrossan Town Hall (sold and unsold) - Monday 2nd April between 10:00am and 1:00pm.

Photography

1. All entries must be the original photograph produced entirely by the entrant.
2. An artist may enter a maximum of five (5) works. They must be entered on a single Entry Form.
3. Entries must not contain trademarks or copyright material owed whole or in part by a third party or violate any persons' moral rights or rights to privacy.
4. The entrant warrants, to the best of their knowledge, there is no cultural, religious, legal or other reason that prevents the submitted image from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
5. The image must not contain any identifiable information of the entrant. Images submitted with watermarks or branding on them will not be considered for judging.
6. Where there is an identifiable person in an image submitted, the entrant is responsible for obtaining a signed Model Release to provide to the Committee if requested. (A Model Release means a release signed by or on behalf of any person identifiable in the image).
7. The image must not contain any material or content that is infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, defamatory, vulgar, pornographic or otherwise objectionable.
8. The image must not plagiarise the work of any other person.
9. The Committee reserves the right in its sole discretion to remove the image if the Committee has reason to believe that any of these terms have been breached.
10. Photography will be displayed at the Yorketown Town Hall over the Easter long weekend. Open Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am to 2:00pm.
11. All entries must include a digital copy of the photograph (for inclusion in the catalogue) and a brief 'Artist Statement' (max. 100 words) including a description of the painting and materials used. The Artist Statement will accompany the work on display.

Receipt and Collection of Photography

1. Personal delivery of photography – Saturday 24th March 2018 between 10am and 3.00pm at the Yorketown Town Hall.
2. Personal collection of works at Yorketown Town Hall (sold and unsold) - Monday 2nd April between 10:00am and 1:00pm.

Sculpture

1. The competition is open to anyone (professional, amateur or emerging artists or groups).
2. Maximum five (5) entries per person or group. They must be entered on a single Entry Form.
3. A maximum of 5 entries must be received for sculptures to be judged and prizes awarded. Sculpture will be judged on creativity, innovation and standard of production.
4. Sculpture to be free standing or self-supporting. Please indicate your preference for tabletop or floor space on the entry form. Protection mats must be provided to safeguard wooden floors at Exhibition space.
5. If it is essential for your sculpture to be hung, it is the responsibility of the artist to provide free standing hanging devices.
6. All decisions pertaining to the display of the sculptures is at the discretion of the competition organiser.
7. Sculptures are entered and exhibited at owner's own risk. The competition organiser accepts no responsibility/ liability for any damage incurred to the sculpture during the exhibition. It is the artist's responsibility to arrange insurance protection for the sculpture if deemed necessary.
8. All entries must include a photograph of the sculpture (for inclusion in the catalogue) and a brief 'Artist Statement' (max. 100 words) including a description of the sculpture and materials used. The Artist Statement will accompany the work on display.
9. Sculpture will be displayed at the Edithburgh Institute over the Easter long weekend. Open Good Friday, Easter Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am to 2:00pm

Receipt and Collection of Sculpture

1. Personal delivery of sculpture – Saturday 24th March 2018 between 10am and 3.00pm at the Edithburgh Institute.
2. Personal collection of works at Edithburgh Institute (sold and unsold) - Monday 2nd April between 10:00am and 1:00pm.

Awards

1. All entries are eligible for judging in the Open Section of the relevant category.
2. The Verna Lock Memorial Award is open to local painting artists only who reside in the Yorke Peninsula Council district.
3. Each work can only be eligible for one major prize (excluding the People's Choice).
4. Major prize winners will be notified prior to Opening Night and announced at the YP Art Exhibition Official Opening in the Ardrossan Town Hall on Wednesday 28th March 2018 commencing at 8.00pm, doors open from 7.30pm
5. The People's Choice award winner will be announced at the end of the Exhibition.

Commission

1. A commission of 20% (+GST) will be charged on all exhibits sold during the exhibition.
2. Payment of sale proceeds will be processed on or before Monday 9th April 2015.
