



School Conditions of Entry

2018 YP Art Exhibition

***Artwork entered must not have been exhibited competitively (excluding local agricultural shows and any school organised exhibitions) within the Yorke Peninsula Council area in the last two years**

For the School

1. School entries will be displayed as a separate entity as part of the Exhibition at the Ardrossan Town Hall.
2. To be eligible schools must be part of the Yorke Peninsula which includes the Yorke Peninsula Council and Copper Coast Council regions.
3. All exhibits must clearly show the artist's name, school, title of artwork, medium on the back of the exhibit if available for sale – or alternatively marked "Not for Sale".
4. Limit of four (4) entries will be accepted from each school in each category e.g. 4 Junior School Entries, 4 Primary School, 4 Middle School Entries and 4 Senior School Entries.
5. The School Entry Form must be filled in with each entry details, clearly showing that work is a School entry.
6. No fees apply for entry in School Section only.
7. Students may enter the Open categories (see the website for the form). All entries in the Open Exhibition are for sale.
8. Students cannot enter into both School and Open competitions with the one artwork.
9. Delivery of Artwork accepted on Saturday 24th March 2018 between 9:00am to 3:00pm or other date as arranged at the Ardrossan Town Hall
10. Collection of Artworks open - Monday 2nd April 2018 between 9:30am and 12:00pm.

For the Entrant

1. There is no fee for entering the School Section.
2. Each entry must be your own work.
3. Any medium may be used for School Section.
4. Works must be suitably presented. (*The artwork must hang straight - not curl on hanging.*) It is a preference that the artwork is framed but not essential.
5. Presentation and originality will form part of the judging consideration.
6. No entry can exceed 1.5 square metres including frame.
7. Entries may be from individual students or groups of students from the same school and category.
8. Awards shown below on this form.
9. The judges' decision is final – no discussion will be entered into.
10. The judges reserve the right not to award a prize in any category if, in their belief, the work is not of a worthy standard for a prize.
11. The Committee reserves the right to remove any unsuitable artwork from the exhibition.
12. Student artworks may be available for sale under the same terms and conditions as the Open Competition (ie 20% commission + GST). If for sale, prices will need to be included on the entry form, or alternatively, marked NOT FOR SALE (NFS).

Awards

1. All entries are eligible for judging in the School Section.
2. Each work can only be eligible for one prize (excluding the School People's Choice Award).
3. Major prize winners will be notified prior to Opening Night and announced at the YP Art Exhibition Official Opening in the Ardrossan Town Hall on Wednesday 28th March 2018 commencing at 8.00pm, doors open from 7.30pm
4. The People's Choice award winner will be announced at the end of the Exhibition.
